What: A three day U.S.C.F stage race (time trial, road race, circuit race). You must complete each stage to enter the next. Qualifiers must all complete the stage 1 TT to enter the RR, and then complete the RR to enter the Circuit Race.
When: TT- Friday afternoon, March 12th/Road Race- Saturday a.m. March 13th/Circuit Race- Sunday a.m. March 14th. See Race Course info inside for layouts and start times.
Where: West Tucson area. Locations, maps, Entry/Release form and other necessary information are also included.
Safety: CPSC or ASTM approved hard-shell helmets & current USA Cycling or approved Int'l license is mandatory.

Check-In: All categories check-in and register at Stage 1 on Friday, March 12th between 10:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. Stage 1 Time Trial starts are approximate.
NO RESTARTS. No late start requests, cat. changes or race day registration. Check-in for racers closes at 3:00 p.m.

Refunds/Late Fees: A \$10 late fee for Juniors and a \$15 late registration fee for all others will be added to ALL online & mailed entries postdated after March 1st 2010. (Note: A \$15 processing fee will be retained on all pre-registered entries who cancel prior to March 5th, 2010.) No Refunds after March 5th, 2010. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Fields: only 100 riders per category (Cat 5 – 50 riders). Register early. Entry limit for PRO/Sr I = 6 per team.

JR. RACERS: Boys and Girls will race together in their respective categories but be scored separately as part of Junior Olympic Road Race Series

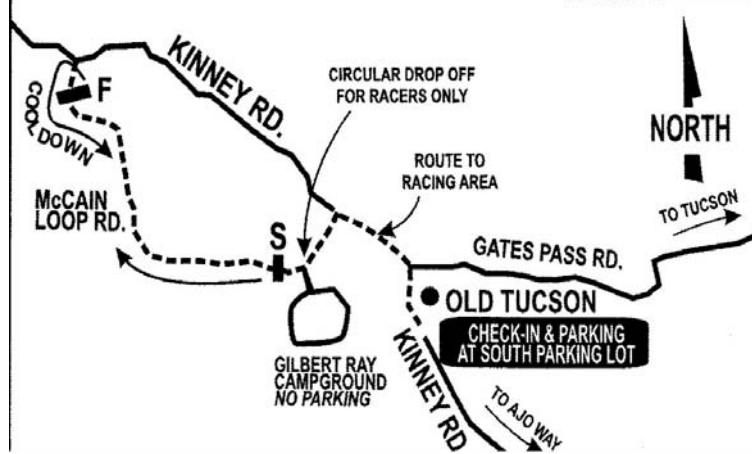

Stage 1 Race Course Map

This beautiful, freshly paved remote 3.0 mile TT course starts out with gentle rollers leading to a 5% climb followed by rollers and a 6%+ climb to the uphill finish. The TT course will be closed to traffic. Registration and parking will take place at the south parking lot of Old Tucson, 1.0 miles from McCain loop turnoff. **ABSOLUTELY NO RACE PARTICIPANT PARKING ALLOWED ON COURSE OR AT GILBERT RAY CAMPGROUND** – designated parking for race personnel only. Riders must ride to the TT START or may be dropped off near the start. Course is closed to warm-up after 11:45 a.m. Watch for late-afternoon traffic on Kinney Rd. Pre-registered start times will be posted on the TBC website (www.tucsonbicycleclassic.com) by Thursday, March 11th and near the registration table. Check in early to review your start times or review them on the website.

Saturday Morning– Stage 2 Sahuarita/Garrett Lemire Memorial Road Race

Plan for 3/4 hour travel time from central Tucson.

A challenging 20 mile loop with approx. 700' of climbing, including a solid, sustained climb just after the S/F line, rollers, flats and a rapid descent. 3 of the 4 roads are lightly traveled. Most of the vehicular traffic will be on La Canada and beginning of Duval Mine Rd. The start/finish line has been moved to Mission Road and Twin Buttes. The race will still travel in a Clock-wise pattern and Entry/Exit to the Twin Buttes will be limited to the La Canada entrance.

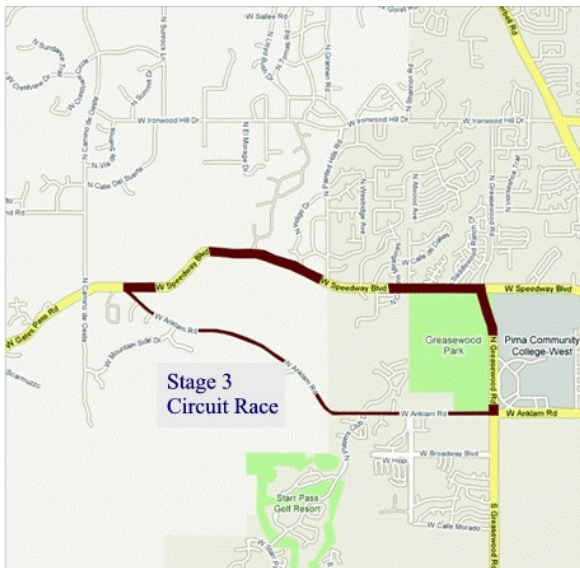
