

2010 Race Bible

1. There will be a Pre-packet pickup at Tri Sports in Tucson on March 6th between 1pm and 5pm. You can't get your start times then but you can register, pick up your number and then get your start times online Thursday March 11th.
2. All Race Numbers must be worn All Days, including Time Trial. Numbers are to be worn on the right and left Sides and bike frame number must be on.
3. Center Line Rule is in effect the Entire race, Time Trial Included. There will be possible time penalties, relegation to last place for stage to possible disqualification and/or suspension for Center Line Rule Violations.
4. You must sign in for EVERY stage, the Time Trial Sign in is when you pick up your number, All riders must sign in before the start of their race. Sign in penalties are 30 seconds for 1st offence, 1 minute for 2nd offense.
5. All Wheels must be at the wheel tent by 6:30am for the 1st wave Stage 2 and by 8:40am for the second wave of Stage 2. For Stage 3 all wheels must be in the Wheel pit 20 minutes prior to the start of your wave, IN the Wheel pit.
6. There is no warming up on the Time Trial course after 11:30am Friday. There is no warming up or riding on the race course after 6:40am Saturday and after 6:35am Sunday.
7. There is no drafting of support vehicles at any time.
8. There is no littering. Pack it in/Pack it out. There will be a 30 second time penalty 1st offence and 1 minute 2nd offence. If witnessed by a police officer, you may be ticketed.
9. There is no public urination. There will be a 30 second time penalty 1st offence and 1 minute 2nd offence. If witnessed by a police officer, you may be ticketed.
10. Junior rollout for all Juniors, no matter the category, will be directly after your race. Do not go back to your vehicle, come directly to the judges stand (safely, not against the racers and do not go across the finish line again. On the side of the Judges stand after the finish line will be Jr Rollout. If you do not do Rollout you may be relegated or disqualified.
11. Once you have finished your race, DO NOT cross the finish line again OR that will be your new finish time. No excuses.
12. You may only work with the group of riders that you started with. Know your race numbers and the numbers that you start with. Depending on the offense of working with the other group will depend on the severity of the penalty.

13. All protests must be presented to the judge's stand within the approved USCF time period for stage races. All protests must be presented in writing recording rider number / rider name / stage / category / issue.

14. Stage 2 parking. You must not park on Mission, Helmet Peak, La Canada or Duvell Mine Rd. You may park at Safeway and ride to the start which is now located on Mission just west of Helmet Peak or you may park on Twin Buttes Rd. Twin Buttes Rd runs East and West between La Canada and Mission. To enter, you must enter off of La Canada and head west on Twin Buttes until you cross the tracks and drive onto the dirt road. The dirt road is in good shape and you must parallel park as far to the side as possible. This is a public road and we must leave room for 2 cars to pass safely.

15. DO NOT PARK in the areas marked off by cones on Twin Buttes and Mission. These areas are reserved for Check in, Wheel Tents and volunteers of the road race.
16. Leaving the road race after you are finished, leave heading East on Twin Buttes the same way you came in. We will not allow Race Traffic to enter or exit from the Mission side.
